The Association of Illinois Soil and Water Conservation Districts is committed to protecting the privacy of your information. As a part of our normal operations we may collect information about you on a limited basis. We encourage you to read the following material that contains detailed information about our policies regarding the collection, use and protection of your information. By visiting www.aiswcd.org, you are accepting the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

In order to better serve you, we collect information about you that you provide to us, some of our affiliates or other related entities. We want you to know that all information collected about you is treated confidentially except as otherwise described herein. We restrict access to nonpublic personal information about you employees, affiliates and others who need to know the information in order to provide services to you. We will never sell information about you to anyone.

AISWCD is committed to complying fully with the Children's Online Privacy Protection Act. Accordingly, if you are under the age of 13, you are not authorized to provide us with personally identifying information and we will not use any such information in our database or other data collection activities. We appreciate your cooperation with this federally mandated requirement. Users are cautioned that the collection of personal information volunteered by children online or by email will be treated the same as information given by an adult and may be subject to public access.

For certain reasons, such as enhancing the programs and services we offer to you, we may receive information about you from other sources as allowed by law. In certain situations, we may disclose information we collect about you to third parties without your consent, as allowed by law. For example, in order to conduct our business we may exchange some information about you with local soil and water district personnel or other board accepted partners. We may share information in our files with other affiliates to facilitate orders or purchases you may make on our site. We have the right to access and correct personal information we collect about you. For example, should we ask for your name and address for an online petition or mailing, we may use this to either print hard copies or send copies via some electronic means to legislators or partners like IFB or NACD.

We receive and store certain types of information whenever guests visit this site. We may collect information including browser type and operating system, areas visited, date and time of access, host of service provider and identification of referring site from all users in aggregate. The information is used to track the total number of guests visiting and allows us to improve the site.

As a service to AISWCD partners, friends and members, this site may offer links to external, unrelated websites. We are not responsible for the content or the privacy practices of those unrelated websites. Before using any site, always be sure to check its privacy policy. Check AISWCD's privacy policy frequently as AISWCD has the right to amend and alter the privacy practices at any time.
