- 1. Currently active Illinois SWCD full or part time (minimum of 20 hours) employees who have been employed a minimum of three years. An Employee is anyone who is hired by the SWCD.
- 2. Nominations for an Outstanding District Employee may be made by any group or individual within the District.
- 3. Nominees must be current and active Employees at the time of local selection and during the 2014 ISWCDEA Annual Meeting.

ORDER OF ENTRY:

Entries must be typed and submitted for $8\frac{1}{2}$ inch x 11 inch paper with all supporting materials, including letters of recommendation.

JUDGING:

DISTRICT: Judging will be completed by representations of the SWCD.

- Letters of Recommendation (20 points) Include two letters of recommendation. One letter can be from local SWCD Directors, SWCD or NRCS staff. The other letter needs to be from an "outside" partner, such as FSA, any partnership not located within local office space or from a different county SWCD Director, SWCD, and/or NRCS staff.
