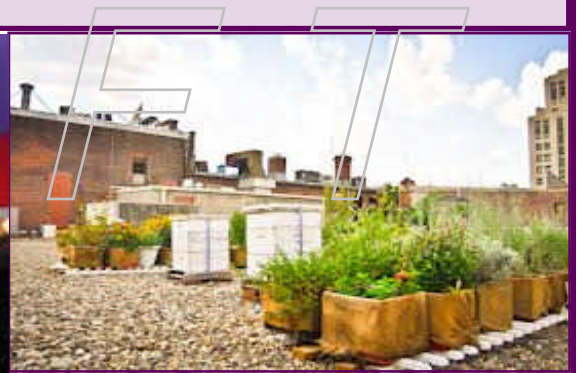

When Caren Trudeau and her son, Chris Trudeau established the brewery in 2011, they drew upon their combined experiences of homebrewing, crafts-

manship and design detail to create the Rolling Meadows brand. Together with Connie and Dustin Regan they have been crafting Rolling Meadows' signature beers- Lincoln's Lager, Springfield Wheat and Abe's Ale- and bringing them to the Springfield area.



Jefferies Orchard is located approximately five miles north of Springfield, Illinois just off Route 29. They are open daily from approximately late April to mid-November with fresh seasonal produce. Call ahead to check what's in season.

Their farm and market are still owned by the Jefferies Family. They've been growing fresh produce for over 65 years! They specialize in produce picked in season. They grow real food for real people.
